COURSE HIGHLIGHT

Study General English to equip yourself for vocational education at a variety of academic providers!

Each lesson is dedicated to developing students' Speaking, Listening, Reading, and Writing skills with an emphasis on the practical application of grammar and vocabulary. Out-of-class activities are organised every five weeks and are dedicated to providing students with real life opportunities to apply their in-class learning.

The ELICOS program's learning outcomes are aligned with the Common European Frame of Reference (CEFR) language benchmarks:

1. Elementary (CEFR A1, maximum exit level Equivalent to IELTS Score 2)
2. Pre-Intermediate (CEFR A2, maximum exit level Equivalent to IELTS Score 4)
3. Intermediate (CEFR B1, maximum exit level Equivalent to IELTS Score 5)
4. Upper-Intermediate (CEFR B2, maximum exit level Equivalent to IELTS Score 6.5)
5. Advanced (CEFR C1, maximum exit level Equivalent to IELTS Score 7.5)

Many Education Providers across Australia will accept a certificate from a CRICOS Registered ELICOS Provider as proof of English, allowing you to successfully progress towards your education goals.

ABOUT ENGLISH FOR ACADEMIC PURPOSES

COURSE HIGHLIGHT

Study EAP to equip yourself for higher education at a variety of academic providers!

EAP course is designed to help non-native English speakers develop the language skills necessary for academic study at higher education institutions. The purpose of this course is to improve academic English proficiency in speaking, listening, reading, and writing; develop essential study skills such as note-taking, summarizing, and research; familiarizing students with academic writing and speaking conventions; preparing for various academic assessments; assist with cultural adjustment to the academic environment; and building confidence in participating in discussions, asking questions, and engaging in critical thinking.

The EAP course is designed in two levels of EAP 1 (Exit level equivalent to IELTS 6.0–6.5), and EAP 2 (Exit level equivalent to IELTS 6.5 – 7.0). There are direct and indirect entries available for this course:

- For direct entry, students must provide evidence of having achieved:
 - CEFR B2 (minimum equivalent to IELTS 5.5) to enter EAP 1 (Weeks 1 to 10).
 - CEFR C1 (minimum equivalent to IELTS 6.0) to enter EAP 2 (Weeks 11 to 20).
- For indirect entry, through the General English program at Tr4inRight or any other registered Australian ELICOS provider:
 - Students who successfully complete the Upper Intermediate Level of General English may enter Week 1 of the EAP course. With this entry requirement of CEFR B2 – equivalent to IELTS 5.5 – students will be able to develop Academic English skills equivalent to CEFR B2 (IELTS 6.0–6.5).
 - Students who successfully complete the Advanced Level of General English may enter Week 11 of the EAP course. Students who complete EAP 2 will achieve proficiency at CEFR C1 (IELTS 6.5–7.0).

The competencies and language proficiencies of this course – if achieved – are measured by Common European Framework of Reference (CEFR).
